Love

- 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 ⁴Love is patient and is kind. Love doesn't envy. Love doesn't brag, is not proud, ⁵doesn't behave itself inappropriately, doesn't seek its own way, is not provoked, takes no account of evil; ⁶doesn't rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things.
- 1 Corinthians 13:13 But now faith, hope, and love remain—these three. The greatest of these is love.

Psalm 84:1-2 - ¹How lovely are your dwellings, LORD of Armies! ²My soul longs, and even faints for the courts of the LORD. My heart and my flesh cry out for the living God. How lovely is Your dwelling place O Lord of Hosts. I long, yes I faint with longing to enter the courts of the Lord. With my whole being, body and soul I will shout joyfully to the Living God.

Proverbs 16:24 - Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

Proverbs 31:26 - She opens her mouth with wisdom. Kind instruction is on her tongue.

Psalm 92:1-2 - ¹It is a good thing to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to your name, Most High, ²to proclaim your loving kindness in the morning, and your faithfulness every night ...

Psalm 138:1-3 - ¹I will give you thanks with my whole heart. Before the gods, I will sing praises to you. ²I will bow down towards your holy temple, and give thanks to your Name for your loving kindness and for your truth; for you have exalted your Name and your Word above all. ³In the day that I called, you answered me. You encouraged me with strength in my soul.

Luke 6:36 - Therefore be merciful, even as your Father is also merciful.

James 5:7-8 - ⁷Be patient therefore, brothers, until the coming of the Lord. Behold, the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, being patient over it, until it receives the early and late rain. ⁸You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.

Ephesians 4:1-2 - ¹I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called, ²with all lowliness and humility, with patience, bearing with one another in love ...

Verses to Pray

Do Not Fear

Isaiah 41:10 - Don't you be afraid, for I am with you. Don't be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you. Yes, I will help you. Yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness.

Psalm 56:3-4 - ³When I am afraid, I will put my trust in you. ⁴In God, I praise his word. In God, I put my trust. I will not be afraid. What can flesh do to me?

Philippians 4:6-7 - ⁶In nothing be anxious, but in everything, by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. ⁷And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus.

John 14:27 - Peace I leave with you. My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, I give to you. Don't let your heart be troubled, neither let it be fearful.

Psalm 23:4 - Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me. Your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Deuteronomy 31:8 - The LORD himself is who goes before you. He will be with you. He will not fail you nor forsake you. Don't be afraid. Don't be discouraged.

Romans 8:38-39 - ³⁸For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from God's love which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Endurance

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 - ⁴Love is patient and is kind. Love doesn't envy. Love doesn't brag, is not proud, ⁵doesn't behave itself inappropriately, doesn't seek its own way, is not provoked, takes no account of evil; ⁶doesn't rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth; ⁷bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things.

Hebrews 12:1 - Therefore let's also, seeing we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, lay aside every weight and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let's run with perseverance the race that is set before us ...

James 1:12 - Blessed is a person who endures temptation, for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord promised to those who love him.

James 1:2-4 - ²Count it all joy, my brothers, when you fall into various temptations, ³knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. ⁴Let endurance have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

2 Timothy 2:10-13 - ¹⁰Therefore I endure all things for the chosen ones' sake, that they also may obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. ¹¹This saying is trustworthy: "For if we died with him, we will also live with him. ¹²If we endure, we will also reign with him. If we deny him, he also will deny us. ¹³If we are faithless, he remains faithful; for he can't deny himself."

Hebrews 10:36 - For you need endurance so that, having done the will of God, you may receive the promise.

1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 - ²We always give thanks to God for all of you, mentioning you in our prayers, ³remembering without ceasing your work of faith and labour of love and perseverance of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, before our God and Father.

Humility

Micah 6:8 - He has shown you, O man, what is good. What does the LORD require of you, but to act justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?

Ephesians 4:1-2 - ¹I therefore, the prisoner in the Lord, beg you to walk worthily of the calling with which you were called, ²with all lowliness and humility, with patience, bearing with one another in love ...

Philippians 2:2-8 - ... ²make my joy full by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind; ³doing nothing through rivalry or through conceit, but in humility, each counting others better than himself; ⁴each of you not just looking to his own things, but each of you also to the things of others.⁵Have this in your mind, which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶who, existing in the form of God, didn't consider equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷but emptied himself, taking the form of a servant, being made in the likeness of men. ⁸And being found in human form, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, yes, the death of the cross.

Colossians 3:12-13 - ¹²Put on therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, a heart of compassion, kindness, lowliness, humility, and perseverance; ¹³bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, if any man has a complaint against any; even as Christ forgave you, so you also do.

Luke 14:11 - For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.

2 Chronicles 7:14 - ... if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

James 4:6 - But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

James 4:10 - Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he will exalt you.

Encouragement

1 Thessalonians 2:11-12 - ¹¹As you know, we exhorted, comforted, and implored every one of you, as a father does his own children, ¹²to the end that you should walk worthily of God, who calls you into his own Kingdom and glory.

Acts 11:23 - ... He exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they should remain near to the Lord.

- 2 Corinthians 1:3-4 ³Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, ⁴who comforts us in all our affliction, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, through the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.
- 1 Corinthians 15:58 Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the Lord's work, because you know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

Stillness And Rest

Psalm 46:10 - "Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted amongst the nations. I will be exalted in the earth."

Psalm 37:7 - Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him. Don't fret because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who makes wicked plots happen.

Psalm 62:5 - My soul, wait in silence for God alone, for my expectation is from him.

Matthew 11:28 - Come unto Me all you who are weary and heavy laden and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me, because I am humble and gentle at heart and you will find rest for your souls.

Exodus 33:14 - My presence shall go with you and I will give you rest.

Isaiah 30:15 - For thus said the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel, "You will be saved in returning and rest. Your strength will be in quietness and in confidence." ...

Isaiah 32:16-18 - ¹⁶Then justice will dwell in the wilderness; and righteousness will remain in the fruitful field. ¹⁷The work of righteousness will be peace, and the effect of righteousness, quietness and confidence forever. ¹⁸My people will live in a peaceful habitation, in safe dwellings, and in quiet resting places ...

Psalm 23:2-3 - ²He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. ³He restores my soul. He guides me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Psalm 62:1 - My soul rests in God alone. My salvation is from him.

Colossians 3:12-17

¹²Put on therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, a heart of compassion, kindness, lowliness, humility, and perseverance; ¹³bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, if any man has a complaint against any; even as Christ forgave you, so you also do.

¹⁴Above all these things, walk in love, which is the bond of perfection. ¹⁵And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body, and be thankful. ¹⁶Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; in all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your heart to the Lord.
